**WEEK 1:**

**Ask a parent:** What act of kindness by someone else inspired you to be kind?

**WEEK 3:**

**Ask a kid:** What random act of kindness can you do this week?

**Ask a parent:** What do you think sometimes holds us back from spreading acts of kindness?

**WEEK 4:**

**Ask a kid:** Why is it harder to be kind to people who aren't kind to you?

**Ask a parent:** Why do you think people are sometimes unkind?
