Basic Truth: Jesus wants to be my friend forever.

Bottom Line: Jesus is there when I need Him.

Bible Words: "You are everything I need." Psalm 119:57, NIV
The Four Friends • Mark 2:1-12

Story Time

Gather children on a rug or in a specific area of the classroom to tell the story. Some kids (*especially the younger ones*) may wander. That's OK. They're still listening and learning!

What You Need: Preschool Bible, doll, baby blanket

What You Say:

LEADER: "Hello, friends! I'm so glad to see you because I have an awesome, true story from the Bible (*hold up Bible*) to tell you, and it's all about some friends! In fact, it's about FOUR friends. Can I get four friends to come and help me? (*Gather four friends to you.*)

"One day, FOUR friends went to see Jesus. They carried their friend on a mat because he couldn't walk. His legs didn't work. (*Lead four friends to hold each corner of the blanket and place the doll on top.*) They believed that Jesus could help their friend. Do you think Jesus could help their friend? (*Pause.*) Let's find out.

"When the FOUR friends got to where Jesus was, the house was FULL of people. (*Lead four friends to stand in front of group.*) It was a BIG crowd. Look at this big crowd! They tried to go through the front door. But there were too many people! Oh, no! What are they going to do? The FOUR friends can't get their hurt friend to Jesus! Do you think they gave up and went home? (*Pause.*)

"Of course not! These friends really believed Jesus would help, so they had to find another way in. They climbed up on the roof and cut a hole in it to lower their friend down into the house where Jesus was. (*Lead four friends to hold the doll up and then lower it down.*) What? They lowered him down from the roof. That is AMAZING!

"Do you think Jesus helped the man on the mat? (*Pause.*) Yes! Jesus told the man to get up and walk and he did! The hurt man got right up off the mat and walked. (*Hold the doll and have it 'walk.'*) Jesus helped him. Good job, my four friends. You can sit down now.

“Jesus is always there when we need Him. And He wants to help us all the time. I’m SO glad that Jesus was there to help the man who couldn’t walk! And Jesus is there for us too. **Who is there when you need Him?**”

CHILDREN and LEADER: *[Bottom Line]* “Jesus is there when I need Him.”

LEADER: “Again! **Who is there when you need Him?**”

CHILDREN and LEADER: *[Bottom Line]* “Jesus is there when I need Him.”

Craft Time

Gather small groups of children around you at a table for toddler craft time. Depending on the size of your group, you may lead the craft two or three times. Not every child may want to participate in craft time. That’s OK. Feel free to send home the craft materials for them to complete with their mom or dad.

What You Need: “Man” Activity Page, scissors, and felt

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Copy “Man” and cut on the dotted lines. Each child needs one man. Cut felt into 3x5-inch rectangles. Each child needs one rectangle.

During the Activity: Retell the story as the children glue the man to the mat.

What You Say:

During the Activity: “Today we heard a story about FOUR friends. They took their hurt friend to see Jesus because he couldn’t walk. They had a hard time getting their hurt friend to Jesus because there were so many people in the house. The FOUR friends had to go on the roof and make a hole! Then, they lowered their friend on the mat down to Jesus.

“Did Jesus help their hurt friend? *(Pause.)* Yes! Jesus told them man to get up and walk and he did! The hurt man got right up off the mat and walked. Jesus helped him. Jesus is always there when we need Him. And He wants to help us all the time.

“Here is a piece of felt. Let’s pretend it’s the mat that the man was on. Here’s the man that was on the mat. Can you glue him on? Good job!

After the Activity: “I’m SO glad that Jesus was there to help the man who couldn’t walk! And Jesus is there for us too. **Who is there when you need Him? [Bottom Line]** **Jesus is there when I need Him.**”
